I _____ being the contractor/owner/occupier of the property
_____ on _____ Road
wish to apply for permission to place a pipe under _____ Road, Rapid
number _____. I wish to lay a _____ diameter (type) _____
pipe in order to carry _____ under the road.

I agree to the following conditions:

1. The pipe is to be laid at least 500mm below the lowest portion of the water table and at least 750mm below the trafficked level to surface at least two metres clear of the road formation edges.
2. The road is to be kept open and adequately sign posted during the laying of the pipe. 'Road Works Ahead' warning signs are to be placed on both approaches 400mm from the trench, for the duration of the works.
3. The road is to be repaired to the satisfaction of the Operations Manager.
4. The owner accepts liability for any accidents of any kind caused through the laying of this pipe under the road.
5. That the Council will not be liable for any damage done to the pipe in the future from any cause whatsoever.
6. That should the Council so require, the pipe must be removed upon notification from the Council.
7. Where a sealed road is to be crossed the seal is to be cut to a clean edge 50mm either side of the trench edge.
8. Where the pipe is to be placed under a sealed surface the least possible damage to the surface is to be done and the surface is to be reinstated at the applicants cost by Council staff.
9. That the excavated trench to be backfilled in layers of granular material not more than 250mm thick, and each layer be compacted before placing the next layer. Any metal excavated from the road formation is to be salvaged and replaced on top of the backfill.
10. The check with Telecom and Electricity Ashburton to ensure that there are no cables in the area to be excavated.
11. I hereby agree to a charge of \$50.00 for permit fee and re-instatement cost of the metal/sealed road surface.
12. No work will be carried out until written permission has been received from the Council to make this crossing.
13. I will contact the Council office and advise of the proposed day and time when work commences in making the crossing.

14. A sketch showing the position of the proposed crossing must be drawn – see attached sheet.

15. **Your attention is drawn again to Clause 9 of these conditions. It is important to ensure any back fill is properly compacted.**
