We had a break in at the Hall on 4/7/19. Police were informed & attended but no further action was taken. Access gained thru mens loo louver window, which Peter has since had covered with bars, made & fitted by Forks Engineering, at no cost.

Peter has also had the Auto flush mechanism on the urinal repaired, several times, at no cost yet again, by Laser Electrical. A new filter has been put in the water line to stop rust flakes & dirt from entering the building pipes.

The annual fire works display had to be abandoned 2019, as the wind was too strong to allow fire to be lit safely.

There has been 3 hall hires, 2x\$120 & 1@\$100

Weed mat purchase has been approved, 1050sq m, \$828

There is a lack of understanding of the new system for the power bill, so Alison will have a lesson with Claire at the council one day to learn all.

Balance is \$5,285

Ian thanked the Council for their continued support with Grants & the Council Reps thanked the Board & volunteers for keeping the Hall in good order. There will be a Council workshop on Policies, Social Media, documentation, fire Regs etc on 21 April 2020.

The ceiling has been cleaned by Wash Rite for \$500 and came up well. Craigs Pest solutions has sprayed for flies again, \$155.25

Claire From the Council informed us we could apply for a grant to put the power underground & re wire the Hall, which we will look at for 2021
