Additional Comments:	<p>We wish to object to inclusion in this document of the playground site at Lake Hood immediately adjoining several of our Village Green development at Lake Hood. To suggest having a free trading area joining residential sections is an invasion of our section purchasers rights to privacy and peace and quiet. This suggested site needs to be removed from the planned Trading In Public Places By Law.</p> <p>Furthermore, there is no power supply near the suggested site so generators would be used as a power source creating unnecessary noise and smell. This by law draft also allows users to set up and operate until 10pm daily. Parking in the area is also limited, with potential road safety hazards for users of the site, which includes high numbers of children. We see the existing playground as a simple place to take children and have a family picnic without any commercial pressures of having to purchase goods.</p>
