I note that the Council proposes allowing a stall to go on the Lochhead Crescent Green. I do have concerns about this as I would hate to see the green be a place where rubbish could lie especially as the Green is open to wind blasts. Currently there are no rubbish facilities provided for on the Green. Please observe the lean on the trees planted on the Green.

Another fear is that this could be the thin edge of the wedge. While one stall for a day might be acceptable it should be noted that many stalls are now self powered and do not require an electrical connection. Also there should be some concern about traffic on the Crescent roadway. There are no white traffic lines all around the Crescent and the small distance between the turns leading into the Brinkley entrance and the turn on the south-eastern side leading to the Stop sign are likely to pose traffic problems.

This is currently a very quiet residential road with no through traffic. I believe that the introduction of any stall is likely to have a significant negative impact on the ambience of Lochhead Crescent. I trust you will consider my concerns when you make your decision. I would be grateful for a response letting me know how my concerns could be mitigated.
