

DECLARATION OF RESULT OF REFERENDUM
WINCHMORE WATER SUPPLY CLOSURE REFERENDUM

I declare the result of the Winchmore Water Supply Closure Referendum taken on Thursday 14 August 2014 for the Ashburton District Council to be as follows:

	<i>Votes Received</i>
FOR the closure of the Winchmore Water Supply	24 (82.8%)
AGAINST the closure of the Winchmore Water Supply	4 (13.8%)

(0 informal votes and 1 blank vote)

Under the Local Government Act 2002, where a water service is to be closed, a binding referendum must be held with electors in the water supply area. A threshold of 75% of votes cast is required for the water service to close. This threshold was achieved as 82.8% of the votes cast favoured the closure.
