Why - There are some items that we don't want in the yellow bin for various reasons. It may be because they are too small to be machine sorted and get lost to waste during that process or, it could be because there is a risk that the container still has residue chemicals in it (for example, aerosol cans).

Tips to recycle it right: Ensure all items are loose (not bagged), empty and rinse bottles, cans or plastic containers (lids from bottles and tins go in the red bin), flatten cardboard and newspapers and ensure your bins are not over-full so the lid can close flat.
