

TINWALD MEMORIAL HALL SOCIETY MEETING

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. Meeting opened at 7.30pm and attendees welcomed by John.
2. John moved we accept apologies, seconded by Alison.
3. John moved we accept minutes from last meeting on 24 Nov 2021, seconded by Caroline.
4. General business:
 - Cleaning – if John needs to isolate, Jacqui & Thorsten will take over cleaning of hall
 - Thorsten still needs to replace screws in men's toilet – will be done asap
 - First Aid Kit has been offered to hall from the disbanding Red Cross group.
 - Grant application deadline is coming up. Suggestions for what the hall needs:
 - 1 - 2 new stoves for kitchen will cost approx. \$1,000 each
 - 2 - new vinyl & floor waste for ladies' toilet – Thorsten to get pricing for plumbing work. Vinyl, like in the disabled toilet, will cost approx. \$1,500.
 - 3 - new collapsible tables are needed – John suggests x10 large and x6 medium. John will get pricing.
 - The larger heat pump quoted at last meeting will cost more, but all present were in favour of this model as opposed to the smaller, cheaper heat pump
 - Alison wondered if groups using the hall needed to scan in to their own covid tracer code or if the hall tracer code was enough. Everyone believed the hall tracer code should be enough. The use of the hall by unvaccinated groups for their meetings did not meet with general approval. Caroline will make some enquiries.

No further matters were raised. John declared the meeting closed at 8.20pm.

Next meeting is planned for 18 May at 7.00pm, the 3rd Wed of the month being more suitable for Caroline.
