Kristin was asking about the stock water race and where it goes. Clare would like a drawing of what is wanted so that she gets it right. Rhonda will tell Clare to not worry about it. Water race people wanted this done.

Mower tractor has a diesel leak and the blades need sharpened. After discussion the Rugby club is responsible for repairs and maintenance because they are the sole users. Rhonda will write a letter to rugby club.

Campground renovations – No water been put on yet. There are eighteen power sites that are workable. Heath will get hold of Pete tonight and he should have poles by the 3rd December for other power boxes. They will be spraying the sites to mark them out. Nathan is getting more spray.
