



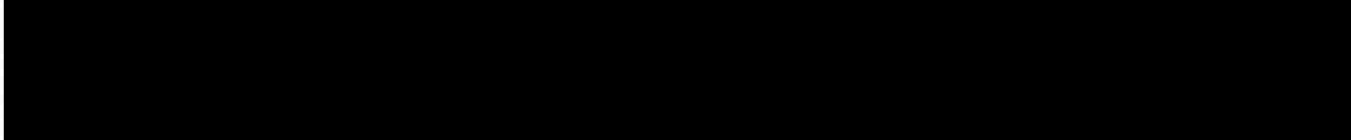

We oppose the proposed developing of the railway land between Havelock Street and the railway overbridge into a proposed parking area for the following reasons.

3. With limited pedestrian access from the overhead bridge, this will add to the danger of pedestrians crossing including many school aged children.
4. Traffic flow from Wills, Cameron and Havelock Street onto West Street and the domain will be disrupted considerably by this proposal.
