Below we have outlined further issues the mobile/stalls will cause: Accumulation of people/crowds Extra traffic (safety concern for young children and animals) Disturbance &amp; noise Potential noise from generators Increase in rubbish On going food smells affecting enjoyment of residential backyards Visual outlook from private backyards Allowing these stalls at the children's playground and picnic area on the south end of Lake Hood are within 50 metres of residential properties, they will spoil the beauty of the natural environment and peoples enjoyment of a true picnic area. Consideration could be given to mobile/stalls only when events take place at the Lake, the north side would be more suitable where there are larger open spaces, more parking and people and well away from residential properties.
