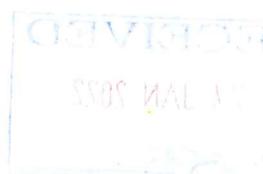

There is an opportunity to get pressured water from the RDR to supply the small number of people that need water, this could be piped from the RDR under pressure from the Surrey Hills Syphon where there is a current outlet, all that would be needed is a reliable meter and charge the shareholders on a per ha basis, for the water used. There used to be a sum of money of \$10,000 available to help people find another source of water, I am not sure why this is still not available because it would help getting piped water to the farms at the bottom of this race, saving a lot of water.
