INTRODUCTION

- 1. This Minute follows on from Minute 1 as issued on 16 November 2023 in relation to the above matter.
- 2. Matter 1 set out a process and programme of exchange of Evidence for a Hearing on the above. Principally, the Minute set out the following:
 - (a) Hearing Date and Venue:
 - Monday 18 December commencing at 10am- Ashburton Council Chamber (Baring Square West/Havelock Street).
 - (b) Exchange of Expert Evidence and Legal Submissions:
