part to be observed and performed, THE COUNCIL HEREBY GRANTS to the Licensee -A. The right to erect _____ metres of _____ fence to bound that area

of the unformed portion of ______ Road ('the land') in the position and

In consideration of the conditions and covenants herein contained or implied, and on the Licensee's

according to the specification approved by the Operations Manager.

B. The right to occupy the land until such right is determined under any of the provisions herein contained.

THE LICENSEE hereby covenants with the Council as follows:-

- That the fence is to be stock proof and of a temporary nature only and is to be erected not <u>1.</u> closer than two metres from the edge of the gravel on a graveled road or three metres from the edge of the seal on a sealed road, and shall be erected to the satisfaction of the Infrastructure Services Manager or his representative.
- That the fence may not be erected so as to enclose both sides of road reserve without special <u>2.</u> authority from Council and if a fence already encloses the opposite side of the road the permit is inoperative until referred back to Council for confirmation.

- That the Licensee, his executors and administrators will indemnify and keep indemnified the Council, so long as the fence shall be on the road reserve, from and against all actions, claims and demands brought or made against the Council in any way arising out of or in connection with the existence of the said fence on the road line adjoining his property.
- 4. That the Licensee will paint the corner or end posts white.
- <u>That</u> the Licensee will not cultivate the road flank until he has applied and received from the Council permission to carry out such work.
- <u>That</u> the Licensee accept responsibility for the cost of repairs to underground water or sewerage pipes or telephone or power cables that may be damaged as a result of the erection, repair or demolition of the fence and will make his own enquiries from the relative authorities regarding the presence of any such pipes or cables.
- That the Licensee accept responsibility for the clearing and keeping clear of all inlets and/or outlets of roadside culverts and cut-outs enclosed within the temporary fence. (Note past experience has shown that stock grazing on enclosed road reserves has caused considerable blocking of roadside drains with resultant flooding).
- 8. That the Licensee will keep cut all growth between the fence line and the road verge to ensure that the fence is visible to road users at all times.
- 9. That if any electric fence is erected it shall be at the discretion of the Infrastructure Services Group Manager or his representative and in accordance with Regulation AS/NZS 3014 2003 Electrical installations – Electric Fences.
- 10. That the Licensee will not construct, allow or cause to be constructed any structure on the land.
- 11. That the Licensee will during the continuance of the license keep the fence in good order and repair.

AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE COUNCIL AND THE LICENSEE -

3.	<u>That</u> the Licensee will not be entitled to a	ny compensation on the withdrawal of th	ne Council's
	consent, and agree to meet the cost of an	y remedial work undertaken by the Coun	icil as the
	result of the Licensee's failure to comply v	with the provisions of the License.	
4.	That no stock shall be grazed within the enclosure during the hours of darkness.		
5.	5. <u>That</u> the licence to occupy is not transferable, and the Council may enter upon the land at a		
	time.
