Executive Summary

Tena Koutou Katoa,

November 2022 proved to be a very busy and productive month in Ashburton. Three Covid cases were reported and successfully managed within our teams to avoid further spread.

Our delivery team focussed on pre-reseal repairs this month, starting on Barford Road and working our way through a demanding program to end the month on Thompson Track. We constructed digout & cement stabilised repairs, improved drainage while shaping shoulders on intersections, filled potholes, levelled services and constructed edge break repairs.

Our minor works team completed several footpath repairs originating from customer service reports, installed slot crossing and sorted a few drainage issues.

Cyclic teams kept potholes under control while focussing pre-reseal repairs and signs across the network.

Our Trading Partners continue to have a strong presence on the network with sweeping, sump cleaning and vegetation spraying.

Our safety focus this month was on managing behaviour inside our road closure, how to engage or report vehicles speeding through worksites.
