Executive Summary

Tēnā koutou Katoa,

I hope this message finds you well. I wanted to provide an update on the progress and activities during the busy and productive month of June 2023.

In June 2023, the heavy dew and chilly atmosphere combined to create ideal circumstances for the formation of ice. These conditions presented a challenge, but our Trading Partners rose to the occasion and demonstrated their excellence by diligently inspecting roads and applying grit where needed across our network, ensuring safe travels despite the icy conditions.

In order to enhance driving safety and increase skid resistance, water cutting was performed on Maronan Road, ARG, and Mount Hutt Station Road. Through the use of a high-pressure water system, we effectively removed excess bitumen by flushing/cutting the affected areas.

The Heavy Maintenance Team made significant progress in rehabilitating unsealed roads during the month of June. They successfully completed rehabilitation works on Coskeries Road, Winslow Westerfield Road, and Tanks Road.

Our cyclic teams continued filling potholes and maintaining signs across the network.

Drainage works have been ongoing, focusing on high shoulder removal and the installation of soakholes.

Finally, I want to highlight that our safety focus this month has been directed towards overhead services, considering the increased presence of truck movements on the contract. We are actively implementing safety measures and guidelines to mitigate any potential risks associated with overhead services, prioritising the wellbeing of our personnel and the protection of infrastructure.


