Our teams responded to a few callouts early-October as MetService issued a red warning for strong winds for Canterbury. Some trees were uprooted, and traffic signs were left battered and leaning over after the severe winds swept through the region, causing widespread damage, with gusts of 200km/h recorded at Mt Hutt's 2069m summit

A great effort from our Heavy Maintenance Crews this month carrying out sealed road repairs on Maronan Road, Tramway Road, Valetta Westerfield and Wakanui School Road

Our Minor Works team dedicated their attention to a couple of larger culvert projects this month, and they accomplished the successful installation of these while also finishing multiple footpath and drainage projects.

Our Cyclic Teams and Trading Partners continued their commitment to maintaining the network.

Upcoming Planned Works - November 2023



Overview

Our Heavy Maintenance Team will continue with Dig Out Repairs on Wakanui School Road, Racecourse Road & Christys Road. We will be focusing on getting a few pre-seal repairs sites completed.

Stab team will focus on completing the remaining flood damage locations along Tram Road and Thompsons Track.

Our Minor Works team will install the footbridge on Allens Road under the guidance of our Structural Engineer who has been involved in the design and construct of the bridge. Following the bridge installation, the team will continue with footpaths repairs, drainage improvements and the handling of urgent CRMs.
