Please note that the commissioner will carry out a site visit, either before, during or after the hearing which may involve them going on to the application site and if necessary, submitters sites. During the site visit, the commissioners will not speak to any of the parties directly about the merits of the application.

<u>To the applicant</u> - please inform the Council if there are any issues with access, such as locked gates or dogs on the site that the commissioner will need to be made aware of.

This information will be provided to the applicant and those submitters who indicated on their submission that they wished to be heard.

- For the applicant: 10 working days prior, being <u>before 5pm</u>, Friday 10th November;
- For submitters: 5 working days prior being <u>before 5pm Monday 20th November</u>;

If you plan to present information on the day that has not been pre-circulated, please make at least **5 copies** available at the time of the hearing for the Commissioner, the applicant and for Councils reporting officer.
