#### **Executive Summary**

Tēnā koutou Katoa,

It's wonderful to give a shoutout to Adrian Blok, Lee Sparrow, Nigel and Sofia for their outstanding work in assembling and installing a first-of-its-kind Infracore Composite Pedestrian Bridge on Allens Road in Ashburton.

The bridge is designed by InfraCore Company (Rotterdam, The Netherlands) and commissioned by Sustainable Infrastructure systems (SIS) in Australia. The deck of the bridge is entirely made of Fibre-reinforced polymers. The lightweight design of the structure makes installation easier with smaller equipment, thereby reducing our environmental impact, carbon footprint, and installation costs. Additionally, it lowers maintenance expenses, contributing to overall cost savings.

Following the bridge installation, the Minor Works Team focussed on footpaths repairs, drainage improvements, sign installations and the handling of urgent CRMs.

Our Heavy Maintenance Team continued with Dig Out Repairs on Wakanui School Road, Racecourse Road & pre-seal repairs on Thompsons Road, while the Stab Team completed the remaining flood damaged locations along Tram Road and Thompsons Track, as well as pre-seal repairs on Middle Road.

Our cyclic teams continued filling potholes, maintaining signs across the network and continued with installing larger advance warning signs at high-risk intersections.
